Fayetteville Golf and Country Club consists of a golf course and practice area/range, club house (dining room, bar, lounge and pro shop), swimming pool and tennis courts located in Fayetteville, Tennessee. The 9-hole regulation length golf course has Champion Bermuda grass greens, Bermuda grass fairways, and a mixture of Fescue and Bermuda grass rough. The golf course has narrow fairways lined with mature trees, water hazards on several holes, and tightly bunkered and testy greens requiring putting skills. An additional set of men's tees can be used when playing an 18-hole round. The course rating is 69.6 and it has a slope rating of 116. The course measures 5727 yards from the men's tees and plays to a par 70. The course measures 4966 yards from the ladies tees and plays to a par 72.

All dues to be paid on June 1 of each calendar year in full for the year or by 12 post-dated checks (dated the first day of each month) for each month of the year. Mid-year memberships are prorated accordingly.

There are no dining room fee requirements. Tennessee state sales tax is not included in the amounts listed above and will be included on annual dues.

Applications for membership to the Fayetteville Golf and Country Club may be obtained from the Club Business Office during normal business hours. Each application should be filled out by the prospective member and signed by a sponsoring current member. Per by-laws, the application will be turned in to the Membership Committee and posted for 10 days before being acted upon by the Board of Directors to approve the application. During this waiting period, the prospective member may use the club facilities as listed in the Membership Privileges section.

GOLF COURSE RULES

Hours of Operation:

Daylight Savings Time (2nd Sunday of March thru 1st Sunday of November), 8:00 am – 8:00 pm

(Hours of operation are subject to change due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.)

1. All golfers are to sign in at the Pro Shop before teeing off.
2. Only two people per cart.
3. No one under sixteen (16) years of age may drive a golf cart.
4. Start play at number one tee, unless specified by the Pro Shop staff.
5. Cart riders are to abide by the ninety (90) degree rule. No carts are to be driven within twenty-five (25) yards of the greens or tees, except on the cart path.
6. No more than six (6) players per group.
7. Please repair ball marks and divots.
8. Please rake bunkers.
9. Putting practice on putting green only. Please retrieve balls hit onto course or regulation greens while practicing.
10. Slower groups must allow faster groups to play through. Golfers stopping at the turn may lose their course priority.
11. Proper golf attire is required (no tank tops, tee shirts, cut offs, etc.).

12. White stakes are out of bounds, red stakes and / or lines are hazards, and white lines signify ground under repair.
13. Any ball hit to the left of the creek on numbers 4/13 and 6/15 is out of bounds.
14. Proper conduct, language, and golf etiquette is required at all times.
15. USGA rules govern play except when modified by any of the above rules or by FGCC management.

GOLF HANDICAPPING SERVICE

For a twenty-five (\$25.00) dollar set up fee, you may obtain a handicap. Please see the club manager or secretary about adding your name to the list. If you participate in this service, you may turn your score cards in at the Pro Shop.

CLUBHOUSE RULES CONCERNING CHILDREN

1. No running inside the building, on the stairwell, or on the balcony.
2. Do not run or play on the putting green. This area is for practice only, it is not a play area.
3. No wet swimsuits inside the clubhouse or on the porch furniture.
4. Proper cover-ups should be worn in and around the Clubhouse when in swimwear.
5. Swimmers are to use the pool house restrooms and showers.
6. The phone in the clubhouse is a business phone. All calls should be limited to three minutes or less.

DINING ROOM

Hours of Operation:

Wednesday thru Saturday, 5:00 pm – Close

Sunday, 11:00 am – 1:30 pm

The Dining Room is open to members Wednesday thru Saturday, 5:00 pm until close, and Sunday, 11:00 am until 1:30 pm. Sunday lunch is open to members and their guests with unlimited visits. Members are always responsible for guest bills or the guest may pay cash.

The Dining Room is available for private gatherings such as weddings, birthdays, anniversaries, school reunions, office parties, business meetings or any special event approved by the Board of Directors and/or Manager. Dining Room rental fees are as follows:

*Clean-up fees range between \$50 and \$100 (check with manager).

Linen napkins and table cloths provided at additional cost: \$5 per table cloth and \$50 for 100 linen napkins.

NOTE: To qualify for the membership rental fee, the person for whom the party is given must be a club member or immediate family of member. All other family members, friends or business associates must pay a non-member fee.

CLUBHOUSE RULES CONCERNING VISITORS

1. All guests are to be accompanied by a member.
2. Visitors are to sign the guest registers located in the Pro Shop or Dining Room areas. No tabs will be made for guests. Monetary transactions shall be made at time of purchase.
3. Club members are responsible for their guest(s).
4. In-town guests may be invited to the club four (4) times per year. Please refer to the guidelines under “Four time guest rule”.

RULES CONCERNING MEMBER’S CHILDREN

Pre-school and full-time students have the same privileges as their parents.

RULES CONCERNING SINGLE MEMBER’S SIGNIFICANT OTHER

A single member’s significant other has full access to club facilities according to the classification of the member (i.e. Regular, Social, etc.) while accompanied by the single member. There is no limit on the number of times he / she can visit club premises.

SWIMMING POOL RULES

Hours of Operation: May thru August

Monday thru Saturday, 8:00 am – 7:00 pm

Sunday, 12:00 pm – 7:00 pm

(Hours of operation are subject to change due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.)

1. Adults must accompany children twelve (12) years of age and under. Unsupervised children requiring the lifeguards individual attention will not be permitted in the pool area.
2. No running or diving; no ducking or pushing people into or under the water; no acrobatics or gymnastics; no fighting or bullying; no swearing or spitting; no standing on or jumping onto floats; no chewing gum while swimming.
3. State law requires that no one with open wounds or sores will be permitted to enter the pool. Swimmers must be in good health and present no danger of infection to others. It is advised NOT to swim if you are suffering from an ear

infection or coughs/colds, etc. Lifeguards and Pool Committee has discretionary powers in questionable cases.

4. No swimmers will be allowed on the lifeguard seats.
5. Smoking will be permitted on the pool deck. Receptacles will be located at convenient locations for the deposit of cigarette ends. Please cooperate in keeping your pool clean and attractive.
6. Food and beverages will be allowed on the pool deck. However, beverages must be in a metal or plastic container. Please, no glass containers permitted.
7. Lincoln County guests may be invited to the pool four (4) times per year and must be accompanied by the inviting member and must register with the lifeguard. Out of county guests may be invited anytime and must be accompanied by the inviting member and must register with the lifeguard.
8. Chairs and tables are not to be removed from the pool deck area.

TENNIS COURT RULES

Hours of Operation:

Open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

(Hours of operation are subject to change due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.)

1. Proper attire is required at all times.
2. Appropriate (non marking) tennis shoes only. Please do not play in any hard sole shoes.
3. Guests may use the tennis courts when accompanied by a member.
4. Tournament play, other than club tournaments, must be approved by the Tennis Committee.
5. Play is limited to two out of three sets or ninety minutes, whichever comes first, if others are waiting for the courts.
6. The last players leaving the courts will secure the courts, turn off the lights, etc.
7. Any player or his guest that violates any of the foregoing may be, at the discretion of the Tennis Committee, barred from further play for a period of time deemed appropriate.
8. Willful damage, other than normal wear and tear, caused by any player or their guest may be assessed the amount necessary to repair said damage.

FOUR (4) TIME GUEST RULE

Golf Course

A guest may play golf four (4) times in a year. The club member and guest must register in the Pro Shop before playing. The four (4) time rule does not apply to the invitational tournaments or special event tournaments. Out of town guest(s) not living in a connecting county, are not affected by the four (4) time rule. However, if the guest is a member of a club in a connecting county, our club will honor the membership and the guest may play on our course unlimited times and the green fees can be billed to their club. All other guest(s) will pay green fees and cart fees at the time of registration or the member will pay or be billed for their guest.

Social Activities

A member may invite a guest four (4) times per year for any social activity at the club. For example, drinks in the bar, a club dance and dinner in the dining room.

Swimming Pool and Tennis Courts

A guest must be accompanied by a member. Guest and member must register at the pool or pro shop. The four (4) time rule applies to the pool and tennis courts. The club considers this a social activity and the same rules will be followed.

Dining Room

The dining room is open to members Wednesday thru Saturday, 5:00 pm until close, and Sunday, 11:00 am until 1:30 pm. Sunday lunch is open to members and their guests with unlimited visits. Members are always responsible for guest bills or the guest may pay cash.

*The four (4) time rule does not apply for special events such as class reunions, weddings, birthday parties, invitational's, or club rental by a member for a special purpose.
